The transition of research discoveries to practical use involves technical questions that are not as sexy as those that have driven the research community and research

funding. Important product issues such as system customizability, computing resource requirements, and usability and fitness for particular tasks need to engage the creative energies of all parts of our community, especially research, as we move machine translation from a niche application to a more pervasive language conversion process. These topics were addressed at the conference through the papers contained in these proceedings, and even more specifically through several invited presentations and panels.
