In 2011, the DocSupp added several executive orders, as the first days of President Obama's administration saw the issuance of several Executive documents of interest to students and practitioners, given their application to detention practices and the broader discussion of the applicable law during armed conflict. Executive Order (EO) 13,567 established a review process applicable to detainees being held at Guantanamo Bay in light of a series of cases decided by the Supreme Court. The primary significance of this Order is twofold-it clarifies the position of the United States in the context of detention in non-international armed conflict, and provides guidance to practitioners on relevant standards and procedures. The Fact Sheet issued in conjunction with EO 13,567 entitled "New Actions on Guantanamo and Detainee Policy" is also included herein. Using terms of art unique to the formation of customary international law, the Fact Sheet announced that the United States "will therefore choose out of a sense of legal obligation to treat the principles set forth in Article 75 [of Additional Protocol I to the Geneva Conventions of 1949] as applicable to any individual it detains in an international armed conflict . . ." The policy merger of law from international and non-international armed conflict will doubtless be the subject of discussion among students and practitioners of international law."
