A good example is an exercise that is performed standing up, standing up will require more muscle recruitment, whereas a laying down exercise will take out all those muscles that were required to stand up, i.e. calves, quadriceps, gluteals, erector spinae, and many more. **Multi-planar Exercises** The exercises listed in this

category are not the only multi-planar exercises, there are many more, a good example of a popular multi-planar exercise not listed here is the kettlebell snatch. The reason the exercises are listed under this category is that there was not one parent exercise category under which they fall. A good example of a non-multi-planar exercise is the shoulder press. Note, whether an exercise is or isn't multi-planar doesn't make it a bad or good exercise, it just describes that it goes through multiple planes of movement.
