**Identifying Potential for Equitable Access to Tertiary Level Science** Oct 29 2022 Higher education internationally is in a state of transition and transformation, leading to an increase in the level of participation, and a consequent increase in number of non traditional and underprepared students. The appearance of these students provides a particular challenge in the sciences where adequate grounding is crucial.
